In Endurance GB, we take our safeguarding responsibilities very seriously and we would like you to have a safe and fun time at this ride. We follow the British Equestrian Federation's safeguarding guidance, and you can read more about this on the Safeguarding section of the Endurance GB website:

How you can help us

- If you are under 18yo, we will need you to bring with you a signed parental consent form confirming that your parent (or whoever has parental responsibility for you) are happy for you to ride
- If you are under 18yo and staying overnight at the ride with someone who does not have parental responsibility for you, your parent (or whoever has parental responsibility for you) will need to sign the part of the consent form to say that this is OK
- If you are under 13yo, you will need to be escorted by a responsible adult on the course. Your parent (or whoever has parental responsibility for you) will need to approve your escort, and if you need to swap escorts for any reason while you are out on course your parent will need to approve the new escort and let the organisers know that they are happy with the new escort.
- Whatever age you are, if you or anyone who is coming to the ride with you has any special needs/health issues and you would like us to make any reasonable adjustments to enable you/them to enjoy the ride more easily, please do let us know.
